#### ANNUAL REPORT

## VICE PRESIDENT, Operations

**2024:** As VP, there were two major areas of interest: Budget and Communications. A dedicated communications schedule was not adhered to, technical problems existed on too many occasions and several one-on-one conferences were not effective. In fact, one was disastrous. I rate my 2024 efforts as a "D+". In 2024 budget management was successful as we are operating in the black. Overall, I grade it as a "B-" because several RC's showed awareness and concern in managing their budgets. However, this was not across the board. Several RCs still either don't understand the budget or ignore it. Correcting this issue is mine to rectify and it also highlights communications weaknesses. **2025**: The following goals are set for the upcoming year:

- 1) Communication: I would like to talk with RCs more often on an individual basis. I will coordinate with them to set something that is mutually agreeable upon.
- 2) Communication: I will set up a quarterly RC ZOOM conference. Include Regional Commissioners and Convenors.
- 3) Budget: submit a 2025 budget on time. Specially, presented to the Board at the Jan 2025 meeting for approval.
- 4) Budget: Improve RC input, understanding and execution of their budgets.
- 5) Awards: continue overall management of the CHS Awards program
- 6) Order of MacEanruig: train a new Secretary to overall manage the Society including voting and awards distribution,
- 7) Fill Regional Commissioner positions at Great Lakes, United Kingdom, and Mid East.
- 8) Personally convene at two Scottish/Celtic Events. Assist Regional Commissioner, NE with convening at least one additional game.
- 9) Personal: Participate in a Roberts Burns event.

#### REGIONAL COMMISSIONER, Central

There are 18 games and festivals annually in this Region. Newly appointed RC.

#### REGIONAL COMMISSIONER. Far South

There are 20 games and festivals in this Region. No report received.

#### REGIONAL COMMISSIONER, Great Lakes

## 2024 Events Convened

Melbourne Highland Games and Celtic Festival - 24th March

Australian Celtic Festival, Glen Innes - 4/5th May

Williamstown Highland Celtic Gathering - 26th October

In 2023 I convened 7 events on the east coast of Aus, the three above, plus Scots Day Out Bridgewater, Hayland Gathering, Brigadoon and Daylesford Highland Gathering. That's something I won't attempt again given the amount of travel involved.

#### 2024 Observations

We always have a good attendance at our Clan tent. Most of the interest is generally on the Collins Tartans Map of Scotland where visitors try to locate their tartan and Clan region. We then refer them to the Scottish Clan & Families Encyclopaedia by Way & Squire for a history of their family name. Most people take a photo of the relevant pages. I have a 29 page Clan Henderson handout which I provide and discuss the contents within, plus sharing details of how to sign up.I have a visitor book if anyone would like to follow up and stay in contact, but so far have only had a couple of acceptances.

#### 2025 Outlook

I will again convene the three events from this year. Not sure at this stage of other events. The **big news** for the Melbourne Highland Games on 23rd March 2025 is that we will be hosting the International Highland Games Federation World Championship!

We have about 50 international athletes plus locals attending, a European film crew for a dedicated heavy games channel, plus various officials and judges. CHS members James Clemmons and Ellen Mallette will be attending and competing, plus several other CHS members attending. Not sure of the details or travel arrangements yet, but it will be the biggest Clan Henderson gathering downunder - ever. Given the number of international visitors next year, our Ceilidh on March 21st will be the biggest ever and we will have to find a new location. There will be a significant Clan Henderson presence at the Ceilidh, and as usual, I will be escorting the Haggis into the hall before the Ode, and drinking the whisky.

#### 2025 Awards

In previous years, CHS presented encouragement awards to dancers competing at the Melbourne event, courtesy of my sister Noela Henderson. In all, she donated \$6,000 on behalf of CHS over three years. Each award was for \$100 to contribute to the recipient's equipment and reimbursed on presentation of the appropriate receipts. This was managed by our local groups, Victorian Scottish Dancers and Glenbrae Celtic Dancers. If there could be an award presented locally, I would like to continue the 'CHS tradition' of supporting our local dance talent through an annual encouragement award.

#### 2025 Budget

\$250 - Public Liability Insurance. This is compulsory for all such events in Australia. To date, I have funded this expense.

\$250 - Printing expenses. This is to cover the cost of producing the handout and business cards.

#### 2025 Budget MEGA Wish List

If we have a number of CHS members arriving next March, I would really like to make them welcome. Some thoughts...

- I am not sure of their accommodation arrangements as yet, but the event will be held in Croydon, about 60 mins east of the CBD.
- The international airport is about 45 mins west of the CBD, so it is a significant trip to Croydon on top of 24 hours of travel from the USA.
- We have no railway from the airport to the CBD it's been in the planning stage for about 50 years!
- Having lived in Oklahoma for a couple of years, and travelled back and forth to Aus, I know how stressful that trip is and the last thing they will need is the hassle of public transport.
- I have a truck with only 2 seats, so would like to hire a mini-bus or similar that I can drive to pick our guests up. A quick look on line shows an 8 seater for \$200/day, or 12 seater for \$300/day, \$1400/week.
- Ideally we would have a few days hire so I could show them some of the sights, but as I am on the organising committee for this event I will be extremely busy.
- And before they depart, some form of CHS celebration/dinner/party.

#### REGIONAL COMMISSIONER, South East

The Southeast Region has an average membership of 250. This year, we have represented Clan Henderson Society at 15 Scottish Games. We hope to add several more Highland Games to our calendar in 2025. The 2024 Annual General Meeting in Charleston SC, coinciding with the Charleston Scottish Games, will mark our final event for 2024. We look forward to ending the year by hosting the Clan Henderson Society 2024 AGM. Additionally this year, two Highland Dancers and four Drummers from the Southeast, have been awarded Youth Scholarships.

Presently, there are 14 Bodyguards serving in the Southeast Region. Notably, this year, several of our Bodyguards contributed to Harry Keifer's project, creating a Bodyguard video for our President Louis Russell. Some additional plans for 2025:
